

# Advanced access

Your clinic has advanced access.

This new system allows you to see your family physician when you need by making appointments available within two weeks following your call.

#### What has changed?

From now on, you can take advantage of this brand new system if you need to see your physician for one of the following situations:

- An acute health problem;
- A regular medical examination (not necessarily annual);
- A follow-up examination (follow-up for a baby, blood pressure, CSST, pregnancy, diabetes).

To do so, it is very important to understand the way this functions and the changes compared

to the past appointment procedure.

Patients will no longer be contacted by the secretary to make an appointment.

If your situation requires, you can now call the Family Medicine Group (GMF) to obtain an appointment. It is important to note that the schedule is only available two weeks in advance and that available time slots are assigned according to the urgency of the problem, following a short questionnaire by the secretary.

Depending on your need, you may be referred to another resource (clinical nurse, GMF pharmacist) or to the walk-in medical clinic.
