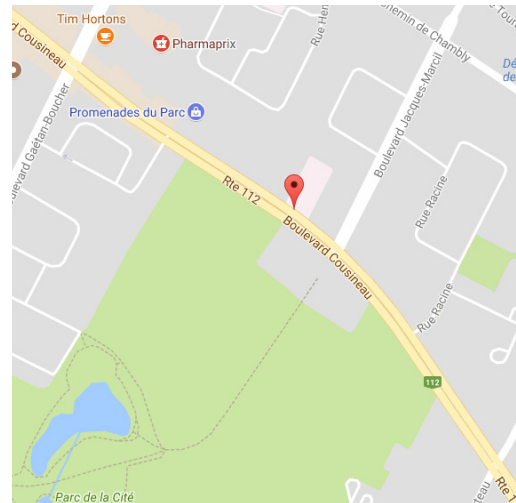

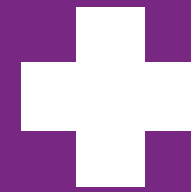

What is the family medicine university clinic?

University students in various fields are trained here.

These trainees play an active role with the patients.

In the case of medical residents, they play the role of family physician throughout their two-year training period.

Trainees are always supervised by an experienced multi-disciplinary team (physicians, nurses, psychologists, social workers, pharmacist).

The clinic offers various services, with professionals from different disciplines. Do not hesitate to ask about the services offered, according to your needs.

What does being followed by a trainee involve?

You will be followed by a trainee who agrees to follow you until his departure (up to two years).

Following this, with your participation, he/she will ensure you are transferred to a new trainee.

What is the pedagogical approach used?

Cameras in the examination rooms are not there to film you. Instead they are directed on the student who carries out the interview and not on the examination table.

The main objective is to observe the trainee in order to provide constructive comments on his/her approach.
